

## Meeting Minutes

### Jefferson Westside Neighbors General Meeting

March 13, 2007

**Presiding:** Paul Conte and Rene Kane, Co-Chairs

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at First United Methodist Church.

#### **Introduction and Announcements.**

- The Executive board members introduced themselves.
- Ilona Koleszer reported on activities of the 3RT (Residents for Responsible Rapid Transit) group that is involved with EmX development.

#### **Report From Co-Chairs.**

The Co-Chairs announced the formation of a nominating committee that will present a slate of candidates for the JWN Executive Board. The slate will be listed in the newsletter, scheduled for delivery prior to the April 10 JWN General Meeting at which Board elections will be conducted. It was also announced that the JWN Bylaws Amendments that were approved at the February 13 JWN General Meeting are now posted on the website ( [www.jwneugene.org](http://www.jwneugene.org) ).

#### **Special Reports.**

- City Council actions to protect Area 15 from incompatible infill were announced, and implications for residents discussed. The need for similar actions to protect other portions of JWN was noted, as well as the need to develop new infill standards.
- The development of new infill compatibility standards, along with the Opportunity Siting process, is proceeding under the leadership of Terri Harding.
- The Minor Code Amendments Project (MiCAP) (formerly LUCA) has encountered difficulties. JWN Co-Chairs and numerous other neighborhood association leaders have sent a letter to Lisa Gardner asking for changes. The next public meeting is April 5 4:00-6:30 p.m. in the Library's Bascom Room.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50p.m., after which Mayor Kitty Piercy talked with and answered questions from the group.
