- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:37. Agenda adjustments none.
- 2. Fiscal Year Board Elections: Sue Cummings re-elected Treasurer. 6 votes in favor. Joyce Graves elected Secretary. 6 votes in favor

### 3. Chair Reports:

- a. <u>Treasurer (Sue)</u>: Outreach postcards will be paid for by the JWN. Sue will explore options for a cheaper printing service. Plans underway for informational JWN doorknob hangers.

- b. <u>Chair (Ted)</u>; Board unanimously approved Eric Dil's minutes of the March 15, 2022, board meeting.
- c. <u>NLC Report Chair</u>: The NLC plans to survey neighborhood board members how the NLC is working with the neighborhood associations. Ted Coopman is a member of the NLC and can designate an attendee in his absence.

## 4. Brief committee reports:

- a. <u>Neighborhood Matching Grant</u>: Mural project at Charnel-Mulligan Park complete. Looking into a mural for the Monroe Park bathrooms when the renovations are complete.
- b. <u>Outreach</u>: JWN door hangers will be distributed in the next week or so. We hope to target the 70% of JWN neighbors who are renters.
- c. Events:
  - i. Summer Picnic: Sue Cummings will organize the picnic and Monroe Park on Tuesday July 26<sup>th</sup>, with Susan Connolly assisting. We want activities to engage families. A decision needs to be made concerning food: Food Trucks or Pot Luck.
- d. Advisory Boards: No news from the Rental Advisory Board or Business Advisory Board
- e. Friends of the Parks affiliates:
  - i. Monroe Park: clean up this Sunday, April 24<sup>th</sup>. Following dates 5/29, 6/26, 7/31
  - ii. Charnel-Mulligan Park: first clean up Saturday, April 16. Following dates 6/11, 8/13 and 10/15. Coordinated with Parks Department
  - iii. Jefferson Dog Off-leash Park: do not know park clean up dates. Sue Connolly will inquire about the clean up dates.

a. The meeting went well, and there was a good turnout. Board Member elections completed with all current board members reinstated in their current positions, and Rene Kane and Joyce Graves were newly elected to the board. There was a discussion about holding 4 winter meetings via Zoom and 6 meetings in-person. We currently do not have the equipment or staff to run Zoom simultaneous with an in-person meeting. (HNRI has a system we could
