2. **Travel Lane County**

Kari Westlund with Travel Lane County, a non-profit group promoting Lane County as a travel destination. In the past, a tax fund was approved for an indoor recreation facility, of approximately 125,000 sq. ft. It would be used for local indoor sports and tournaments. The next step is waiting on the Lane County Events Center 20-year master plan. The facility may replace an existing building and may also be used during exhibitions, the annual fair and for emergencies. Check the JWN website for updates.

3. **Arjorie Arberry-Baribeault , Environmental Justice Organizer and Zach Mulholland Beyond Toxics West Eugene**
 - a. Currently there is the Clear Lake Overlay Zone which is a buffer between neighborhoods and industrial areas in west Eugene. The Beyond Toxics group wants to expand the overlay zone as neighborhoods develop and as new businesses are approved. JWN is asked to support the Beyond Toxics plan. JWN Board to discuss.
